## BIOGRAPHY - ARTISTIC PRACTICE

I am an artist and film maker. I have an MA in film, art and new media from the universities of Lund, Copenhagen and Gothenburg, and a diploma degree in classical animation from Eksjö.

Someone called my work "everyday life surrealism", which I think is a quite adequate description. It is usually very hands-on realistic, but with a dreamlike, contrasting dimension. I like to play with different perspectives, different scales; micro and macro cosmos, problemizing our common sense observations, giving our trivial life an air of mysticism and romanticism. Like a gradual fall into a fever dream.

My work is usually presented in a wide range of forums. The animated film series *The Tale of Little Puppet*boy was originally shown, and made for, gallery screenings. But it has also been shown widely on festivals around the world, most notably at the Cannes Festival, which is a diametrically opposed scene. The music videos were made for distribution on TV, but have also been shown widely on galleries and film festivals. I like that aspect of it, the quality to communicate through both what is commonly characterized as "high culture" - and "low culture" channels.

I work with narration, but to me it is not so important through what media that narration is told. It could be through sculpture, performance, film, or all at the same time. I think it is especially interesting when the story blends with our physical world, what we usually call "reality". The long lived epic saga on Puppetboy is aiming at blurring those boundaries. It started off as a fictive, clay animated slap stick film series, and has gradually transformed into a live action existentialist drama, involving real people - and specifically myself. At gallery screenings I like to incorporate performance in the show.

For a couple of years I worked as a researcher in the fields of interactive animation and computer art for two different studios. I have created a few major interactive pieces, among these two self generative films, a computer tool for character animation, and a cd-rom compilation of swedish computer based art.

I have been teaching and have had many workshops at university level; a.o Valand School of Fine Arts, Gothenburg, Royal University College of Fine Arts, Stockholm, The School of Film Directing, Gothenburg, Art & Technology, Gothenburg, Electrohype, Malmö, Dômen Art School, Gothenburg and University of Skövde.
